



ADA Accessible Exam Tables

Key Requirements *(Per the U.S. Access Board)*



Height Range & Adjustability

- ✓ Adjustable Height: **17-19 in. to 35-37 in.** above the floor
- ✓ Operable without tight grasping, pinching, or twisting
- ✓ Height adjustment controls must be accessible from supine and seated positions



Transfer Access & Clearance

- ✓ Clear floor space for side transfers: **30 in. x 48 in. min**
- ✓ Knee clearance under table: **27 in. high min, 30 in. wide min, 19 in. deep min**
- ✓ Space for patient lifts and assistive devices



Safety & Stability

- ✓ Stable base with minimal movement during transfers and positioning
- ✓ Side supports, stirrups, and accessories must be removable or fold away
- ✓ Weight capacity appropriate for the patient population



Controls & Operation

- ✓ Controls must be easy to reach and operable with one hand
- ✓ Require minimal force (5 lbs. max) to activate
- ✓ Clearly labeled and understandable
- ✓ Do not require tight grasping, pinching, or twisting



Support & Positioning

- ✓ Adequate back support and positioning for patient comfort and safety
- ✓ Leg supports adjustable and accessible
- ✓ Paper roll holders, hand-rails, and accessories must not impede transfers
